

Triangle Folklore Festival 2026

Dear friends,

Application for Triangle Folklore Festival 2026 has closed.

Triangle Folklore Festival will take place 26/7-1/8 2026 in the city of Vejle, Denmark.



Triangle Folklore Festival offers participation in an international festival with 10 folklore groups from 6-8 European countries and 2-4 countries from other continents of the world.

The festival includes: two gala shows; cultural exchange evenings (workshops), where each participating group teaches a couple dances from their country; and lots of dancing in the city squares and streets of Denmark.

The festival includes 3-5 performances by each group lasting 25 minutes each, with some being outside on public squares. The groups can bring different routines for this if they wish to. Additionally, each group will perform at two gala shows each lasting 8 minutes and must perform the same routine at both gala shows. This takes place at an indoors stage.

During the festival the participating groups will be shown different attractions and, hence, be given an impression of the country.

The groups can consist of a maximum of 25 people (including officials) at the age of 18-35 years. The groups must bring their own live music. The participating groups are expected to perform in replicas of traditional costumes with a varied and entertaining dance programme.

All groups are expected to arrive in their own bus for transportation during the festival. All costs for transport to and from the festival AND during the festival must be held by the group. There will be about 400-600 kilometres (300 miles) of transport during the festival, excluding any sightseeing the groups might plan on their day off.

As participants of the festival the group must take part in all events planned for the group. It is crucial that the appointed programme is followed by all participants, which includes being punctual: being at the right place at the right time.

In return, the festival committee offer a well organised and detailed programme and full accommodation from the time of arrival until departure from the festival. The accommodation is in school classrooms with two classrooms for each group. There will be three main meals every day and the food will be varied and well-prepared.

Smoking is not allowed on the school's property due to Danish legislation, and it is very important that this is respected.

During the entire festival there is at least one English-speaking guide assigned to each group; This guide will help the group in every way.

Each group will receive an individual programme in English.

Each group gets one day off for sightseeing, shopping, relaxing or what else they might want to do.
